

Oct 03, 2025, NYCRGC Board of Directors Meeting. Meeting called to order 6:30 PM.

Attending Board members: 1.) Todd Corriveau, 2.) Bruce Hill, 3.) Ray Hill, 4.) Denise Carpenter, 5.) Jean Demuele.

New Business:

1. As this was the first board meeting without Bruce Ballard as chairmen. The meeting format was changed due to that reason. We began the meeting trying to elect a chairman.
2. Todd Corriveau was elected Board Chair but with reduced responsibilities. (There was no one that could do all the things that Bruce Ballard did).
3. Todd will run the meetings, take and read the notes of the meeting. All other responsibilities will be divided between all other members of the board. The board will finalize the division of responsibilities in later meetings.
4. A finale note from Bruce Ballard was about the web site. He feels that the current situation of the web site is a bad situation for the club. The excessive cost and difficulty using it is not worth it according to Bruce Ballard. The board voted and unanimously agreed. The new options that were discussed were:
 - a. Dismantle the web site and use Facebook more aggressively for club business.
 - b. Cindy Peesle mentioned she could start and run a new site. We will ask her during the meeting about it.
 - c. A new member, last meeting, mentioned that they were in the IT line of work and could run a site. Cindy was going to try and contact the member about it.
 - d. We also discussed the second Facebook account that we lost control over and how we can get it deleted. Romeo may have some information and we will try to contact him about it.
5. A proposed change in the By-Laws as follows; A Director at large position is opened for anyone that ran for the position but did not win the vote. They can sit in at meetings but not have a vote. In the event that a director is not present for a vote the Director at large can vote on that matter. Still investigating if it is feasible according to parliamentary rules.
6. A list of sponsors and active volunteers and a way to display them at events.
7. Ray Hill will add up the volunteer hour cards
8. New shooting events.
 - a. A small bore shoot (22 LR) rifle shoot
 - i. Rules (NRA small bore rules)

- ii. How it would be run
 - iii. Cost and profit (Minimum costs for paper targets, stands can be made)
 - iv. Equipment (Paper targets, stands and some sort of ground cover)
 - v. This event can be started this spring. Starting to gather supplies.
 - b. Trap shooting event
 - i. Equipment (Clay trap shooter)
 - ii. Range adjustments needed
 - iii. Cost
 - iv. More investigation and it may cost more than that can be spent at this time.
- 9. Range improvements and repair.**
- a. Pistol Range
 - i. This spring we will finish on the berm improvements
 - 1. Build up the berms
 - 2. Build/buy the wooden barriers around the base of the berms.
 - 3. Cut the trees and brush from the edges of the range.
 - b. Rifle Range
 - i. Begin saving up for the expansion of the berms.
 - ii. Cut the trees and brush from the edges of the range.
 - c. Shotgun Range
 - i. Just keep the grass cut and brush cleared until the decision on the Trap shoot is decided.
